ART MADRID'23 WILL GATHER A SELECTION OF 35 NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL GALLERIES

- › **ART MADRID celebrates its eighteenth edition from February 22 to 26, 2023 at the Galería de Cristal del Palacio de Cibeles.**
- › **The fair's Selection Committee has assessed the set of proposals to offer a high artistic quality in its programming and for visitors to enjoy an extensive overview of the most up-to-date contemporary art.**
- › **The new edition of ART MADRID will feature 9 international galleries from France, Portugal, Italy, Germany, Taiwan, and Cuba, with 26 national galleries from all over Spain.**

Madrid, December 2022.- The ART MADRID Selection Committee has once again been in charge of evaluating the applications of galleries interested in participating in the eighteenth edition of the fair. The Committee is composed by Alfonso de la Torre (critic and curator), Aurora Vigil-Escalera (gallery owner), Natalia Alonso (critic and curator), Angel Samblancat (international fairs advisor), Javier López (gallery owner) and Ana Suárez (art adviser).

The selection is made to guarantee a high level of artistic quality in the ART MADRID'23 programming. For this reason, the applications are evaluated taking into account both the proposal presented by the gallery and the career of its artists.
