ART MADRID'20 CELEBRATES ITS 15TH ANNIVERSARY WITH THE MOST DYNAMIC EDITION EVER

- › **Art Madrid celebrates 15 years of the fair with an energetic vibe edition**
- › **41 galleries and nearly 200 artists, including 13 galleries participating for the first time**
- › **The One Project program presents its most innovative proposal under the title of *Salvajes. La cage aux fauves* curated by Fernando Gómez de la Cuesta**
- › **Mario Gutiérrez Cru renews as curator of the ART MADRID-PROJECTOR'20 program dedicated to visual and interactive arts and action art**

Art Madrid celebrates its 15th edition from the **26th February to the 1st March**, 2020 in the Crystal Gallery of Cibeles Palace [c/Montalbán, 1]. A sophisticated space in the centre of the capital that will host **41 national and international** galleries that will exhibit works by almost **200 artists**, both emerging and mid-career creators.

The fair is transformed into a dynamic event where the audience will enjoy an immersive experience in contemporary art thanks to our programming of actions outside and inside the fair.

Art Madrid defines itself as an **open and global proposal** that offers the perfect opportunity to discover and acquire singular works by dozens of artists covering all disciplines: painting, sculpture, graphic work, photography, video art and artistic installations.

On its 15th anniversary, Art Madrid brings together **27 national and 14 foreign** exhibitors from **9 countries**. From France, Portugal, Austria, Germany and Italy, through Ecuador and Cuba to Taiwan.

Art Madrid will have 13 new galleries: **es.Art Gallery** of Malaga, **Galería ATC** of Santa Cruz de Tenerife, **Galerie LJ** of Paris, **Galleria Stefano Forni** of Bologna, **Kaplan Projects** of Palma de Mallorca, **Luisa Catucci Gallery** of Berlin, **MA Contemporary Art** of Palma de Mallorca, **Más ARTE Galería** of Quito, **N2** of Barcelona, **Offspace| galerie panoptikum** of Gilgenberg, **Pigment Gallery** of Barcelona, **Plastic Murs** of Valencia and **Urban Spree** of Berlin.

Under the enigmatic title of ***Salvajes*** Art Madrid wanted to go a step further in its **ONE PROJECT** program, turning it into a sphere of dialogue [but also of conflict] where nine artists will share the space face to face presenting specific projects to the fair. The program is directed by the art critic and independent curator **Fernando Gómez de la Cuesta**.



For the **ART MADRID-PROJECTOR'20** program, Art Madrid trust again on **Mario Gutiérrez Cru**, director of the pioneering video art festival **PROYECTOR**, who will be the curator of this program dedicated to **visual and interactive arts** and **action art**. The goal is to involve the public outside and inside the fair through performances, masterclasses, meetings with artists and a cycle of screenings.

All the details of this program will be soon published, starting on **12th February and ending on 1st March**, with the collaboration of spaces such as Medialab Prado and Sala Alcalá 31.
