THE 17TH EDITION OF ART MADRID, THE CONTEMPORARY AND EMERGING ART FAIR, OPENS TOMORROW TO THE PUBLIC.

› The ART MADRID fair opens its doors from Wednesday 23 to Sunday 27 February at the Crystal Gallery of the Palacio de Cibeles (Montalbán, 1). It can be visited every day from 11 am to 9 pm.

› Art Madrid'22 is the Art Week fair with a strong multidisciplinary character in which 35 national and international galleries participate, representing more than 160 artists working with painting, sculpture, graphic works, photography and video art, from the early 20th century to the present day. The fair is characterized by being a proposal close and open to all audiences who want to know the reality of the contemporary art world.

"ONE SHOT COLLECTOR, ART MADRID'S COMMITMENT TO COLLECTING.

With the support of One Shot Hotels, ART MADRID offers visitors the "One Shot Collectors" initiative, a collecting program integrated into the fair, whose commitment is to continue building bridges so that the public can access contemporary art. This initiative is aimed at both professionals in the sector and contemporary art lovers who are thinking of getting started in collecting and would like to be accompanied and guided during their visit to the fair.

In this edition, ART MADRID will count on the advice of Ana Suárez Gisbert, a law graduate and expert appraiser, with extensive experience in the art market.

The "One Shot Collectors" initiative also includes the "Iconosphere" tour curated by Natalia Alonso. This is a different way of looking at the fair, allowing visitors to tour the fair and delve into specific aspects of the works and the 12 selected artists. The curator will conduct a guided tour on Thursday 24 and Friday 25, at 5 pm.

ART MADRID - PROYECTOR, A SPACE FOR AVANT-GARDE ART

ART MADRID renews its alliance with PROYECTOR, a platform for the dissemination of the moving image, emphasizing its most experimental, contemporary and committed character. On this occasion, the program presented revolves around the concept of "loop".

On Wednesday 23rd, the ARTMADRID-PROYECTOR stand will host, at 8pm, the performance "Always But a Stone Thrown Away" by Gary Hill, pioneer artist of new media art; while on Friday 25th, at 8pm, it will be the turn of Llorenç Barber, pioneer of Spanish sound art, who will perform a sound action exclusively for the fair.
