



IT'S ALL SET! THE 19TH EDITION OF ART MADRID'24 GETS UNDER WAY

- The Galería de Cristal del Palacio de Cibeles opens its doors to host the 19th edition of Art Madrid. An unmissable event for collectors, art lovers and professionals of the sector during Art Week.
- From Wednesday, March 6 through Sunday, March 10, the fair offers a General Program made up of 36 national and international galleries, as well as a Parallel Program consisting of curated tours, performances and exclusive installations.
- New for this edition and in collaboration with One Shot Hotels, Art Madrid will award the ONE SHOT prize to give exposure and support to an emerging artist.

Madrid, March 6, 2024. The Galería de Cristal del Palacio de Cibeles opens its doors today, **Wednesday March 6, to host the 19th edition of [Art Madrid'24](#)**. The contemporary art fair, which is part of the capital's **Art Week**, has consolidated itself year after year as an unmissable event for collectors, art lovers and professionals in the sector.

Until next Sunday the 10th, from 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Art Madrid will be presenting an exciting panorama of the **latest contemporary art** through works from **[36 carefully selected national and international galleries](#)**. The proposals, marked by experimentation and plurality of aesthetic approaches, will turn the Galería de Cristal into a window open to the most groundbreaking artistic trends thanks to the talent of the **[artists taking part](#)**.

On the national level, **25 Spanish galleries** will participate in this new edition, two of which are joining the fair for the first time, showcasing the abundance of talent on the Spanish art scene. What's more, there will be a strong intercultural dialogue thanks to the participation of **11 international galleries** from countries like France, Italy, Portugal, South Korea, Taiwan, Chile and Cuba, enriching the experience with new ideas and perspectives.

AN EXTENSIVE OFFER OF PARALLEL ACTIVITIES

Art Madrid'24 boasts a [wide range of activities](#) that will take place during these days in its usual space at the **Galería de Cristal of the Palacio de Cibeles**. Coinciding with the opening of the fair, **Reunión de gente importantísima** by the artist **Marina Tellme** will be unveiled as part of the new **OPEN BOOTH X LIQUITEX**, a space devoted to giving prominence to emerging artists. The public will be able to enjoy this exclusive installation at stand D2, immersing themselves in an absorbing experience that provides a subversive glimpse into established social relations in the art world.

At 5:45 p.m. this afternoon, visitors will be able to participate in **the curated walkthrough LECTURAS** by the popular art historian **Eugenia Tenenbaum**, who will reveal the tensions that occasionally arise between artist and work, spectators and space, and art and market. At 7:00 p.m, the performance **Vacío, from the FOMO series** by **Mónica Egido**, will take place as part of the **INTERCESIONES X TARA FOR WOMEN** cycle. Through this performance, the artist seeks to reflect on the impact of long-term anxiety on the physical and mental health of many millennials.

On Thursday, at 5:45 p.m., **Oscar Manrique** will be in charge of curating the **LECTURAS** walkthrough to explain how the different artistic representations in the exhibited works are born out of the need to renew the discipline of painting in the face of the image-ridden reality we live in. At 7:00 p.m. **Sara Gema Domínguez** will perform **Bingo de artista** as part of the **INTERCESIONES** cycle. In this, she will invite the public to take part in a game in which they themselves will become creative actors.

CURATED WALKTHROUGHS AND PERFORMANCES FOR THE WEEKEND

The afternoon of Friday the 8th will begin with the performance **Maternidad 4. Amamantar** by **Teresa Búa** for the cycle **INTERCESIONES**, which will commence at 5:00 pm. The artist invites us to witness the beauty of the maternal experience of breastfeeding as a source of creativity in the intercession of life. There will also be the opportunity to participate in the curated walkthrough **LECTURAS**, again by **Óscar Manrique**, at 6:00 pm.

On Saturday, at 7:00 p.m., it will be the turn of **Estel Boada** and her performance **Stand, By Me**, which will conclude **INTERCESSIONS X TARA FOR WOMEN**. The artist will give her ironic and humorous take on responsibility from the perspective of an art fair stand.

Finally, on Sunday 10 at 6:00 p.m., the public will have a new opportunity to discover the artists and galleries participating in this 19th edition of Art Madrid thanks to **Eugenia Tenenbaum** and her curated walkthrough **LECTURAS**.

ONE SHOT: EMERGING ARTIST AWARD

As a first for the 19th edition, **Art Madrid** will award the **ONE SHOT prize** to an emerging artist in order to promote innovation, experimentation and diversity in the contemporary art scene. The award is supported by the hotel chain **One Shot Hotels**, which for four consecutive years has supported the event's artistic offerings. The main objective of the award is to **give exposure and support to emerging artists** who have a strong commitment to creation and sustainability.
