ART MADRID CLOSSES ITS 17TH EDITION WITH A SIGNIFICANT INCREASE IN VISITORS AND SALES

ART MADRID, which was held in the Glass Gallery at Cibeles Palace from 23 to 27 February, closed its 17th edition with more than 16,000 visitors, a figure similar to that before the pandemic. The fair was attended by many people, including: Andrea Levy, Delegate for Culture, Tourism and Sport from Madrid City Council; Begoña Villacís, Deputy Mayoress of Madrid City Council; several Ambassadors; representatives of museums from all over Spain; and heads of important national and international collections.

Alberto Cornejo, director of ART MADRID, comments: "We are very satisfied with the results of this edition. After these years of uncertainty due to the pandemic, we are happy to see that the public and collectors continue to respond to the fair with the same enthusiasm as in previous years. It is interesting to note that sales in this edition were very strong, reflecting the great vitality of the Spanish art market. In this respect, it is worth noting that our VIP programme for advice to collectors, directed by Ana Suárez Gisbert, has been a great success, providing service to experienced collectors and generating new buyers.
